By registering, a delegate agrees to participate in the YMCA Center for Civic Engagement's experimental Youth in Government (ZIG) conference, to abide by the YIG Code of Conduct, ZIG Code of Conduct, and to behave in a positive manner. I understand that I may be removed from the virtual conference if necessary. The Code of Conduct below serves as an extension and supplement to the CCE Code of Conduct.

- 1. Appropriate Video Call Etiquette:
  - When registering/signing-in for any video call or meeting, please use your registered First & Last Name, as well as your school. Example: "Elise Dugger- CCE School". This helps us to ensure the privacy of our meetings.
  - Please find a quiet area and call-in at the scheduled time so you can be fully present.
  - Please do your best to keep background noise or distractions to a minimum.
  - Please do not take your phone or computer to the bathroom.
  - Photos and videos of others without their expressed consent is prohibited.
- 2. Appropriate attire: ZIG attire is YIG business attire. Appropriate attire must be worn at all times. Clothing with vulgar language, obscene gestures, racial slurs, or anything that contributes to a hostile environment or would be considered inappropriate is not allowed. Appropriate tops and bottoms should be worn.
- 3. Appropriate language: Vulgar language, including swearing, name-calling or shouting/yelling at others is prohibited. When communicating in the chat box, please do not send links or information that is not aligned with our YMCA values.
- 4. Creating a welcoming environment: Respect others' cultures and personal way of being. We strive to create a safe emotional and physical space. We encourage
- 5. Removal from the conference: Any delegate violating the YIG or ZIG Code of Conduct will be removed from the conference and any ballot. Anyone removed from the conference will not be allowed to attend future CCE conferences.
